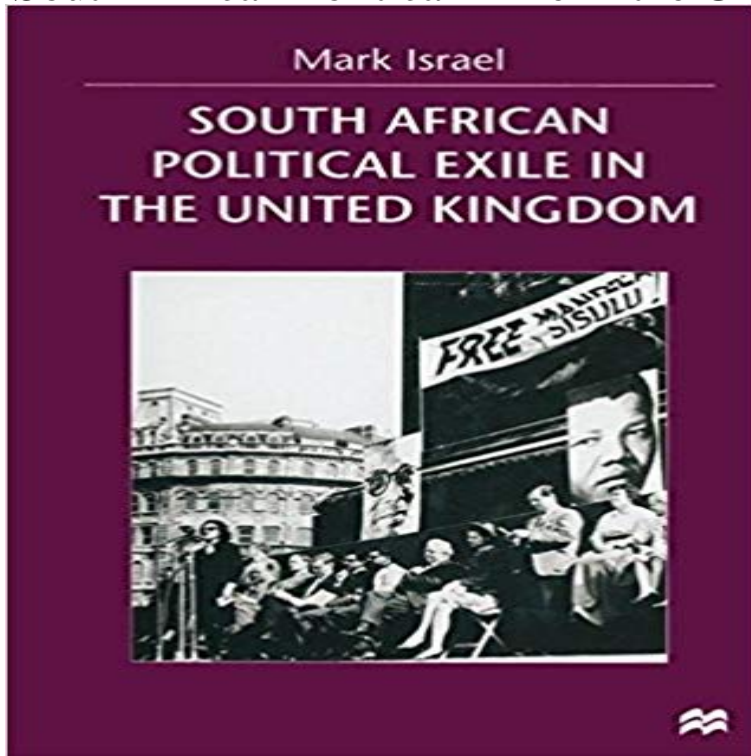


## South African Political Exile in the United Kingdom
