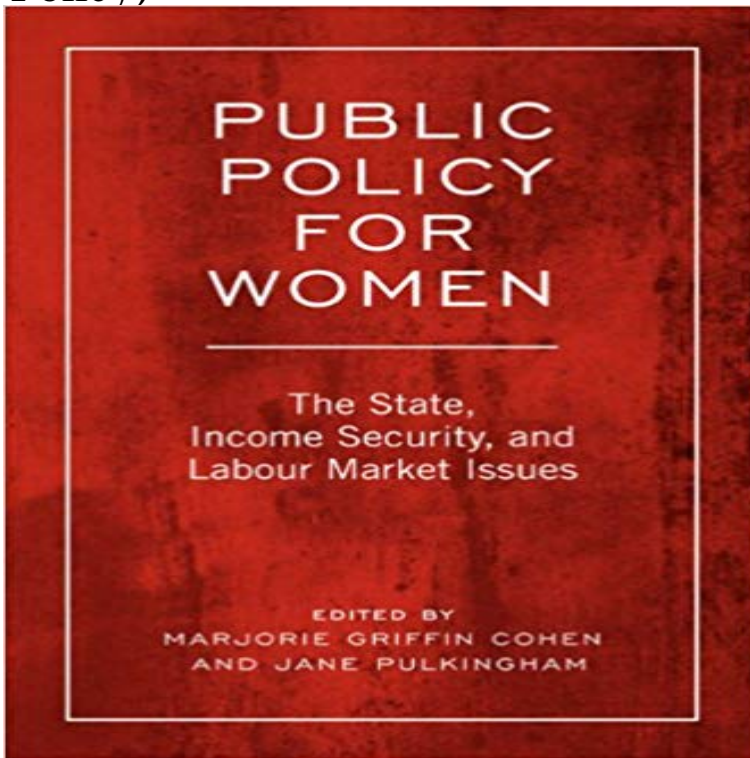


# Public Policy For Women: The State, Income Security, and Labour Market Issues (Studies in Comparative Political Economy and Public Policy)
