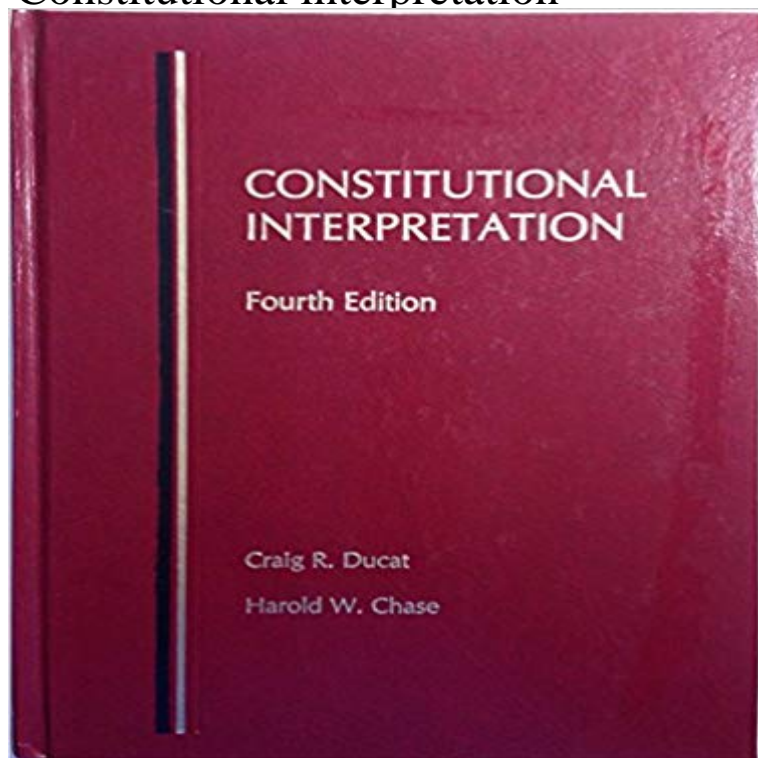


## Constitutional interpretation
