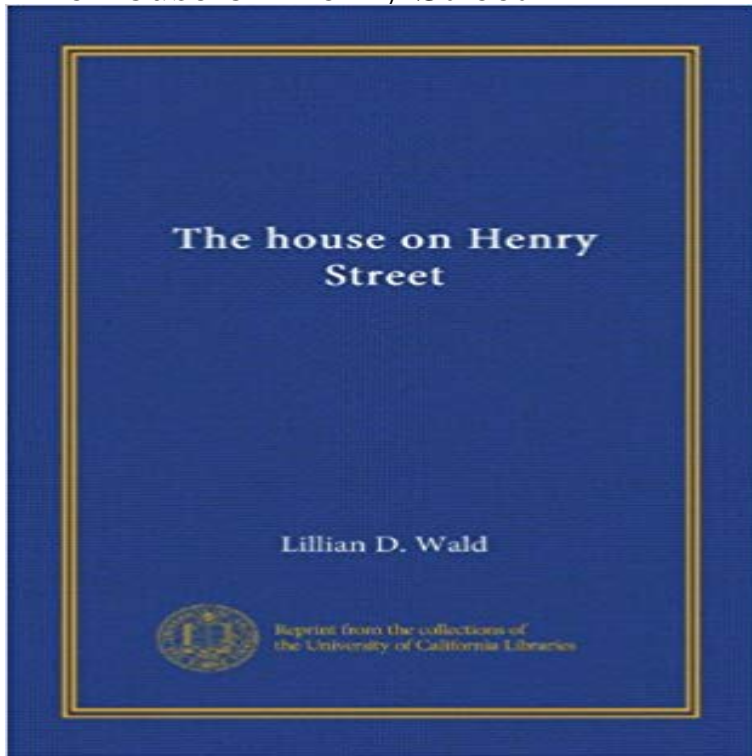


The house on Henry Street
