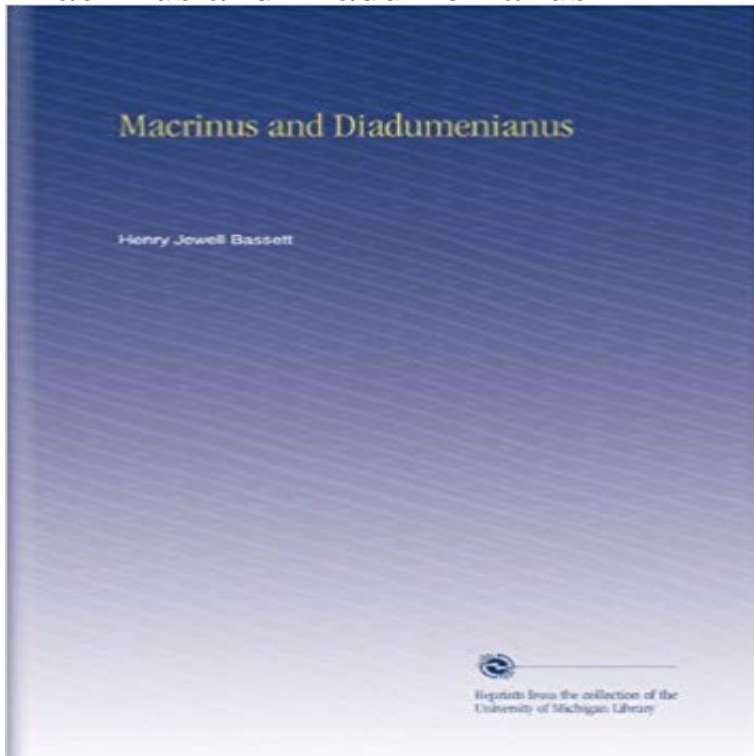


## Macrinus and Diadumenianus
