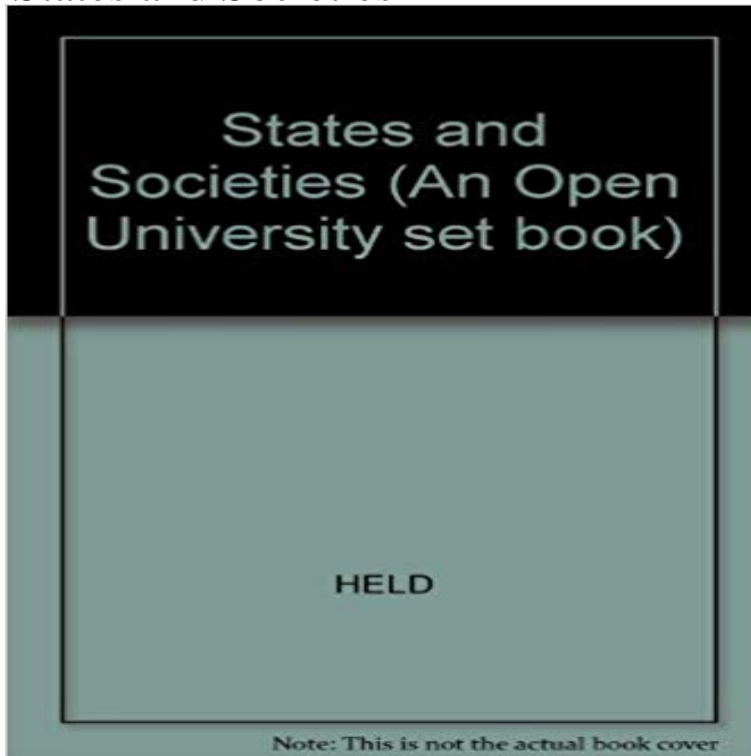


States and Societies



For centuries the state has been the central element in the work of political scientists and philosophers. It is the focal point of many debates in sociology and economics. Thompson, Nozick and others focus on the nature and development of the state. Introductions and analyses by the editors themselves provide a continuous critical narrative, linking separate themes. The whole is prefaced by David Held's substantial introductory essay, which provides a far-reaching analysis of the concept of the modern state.
