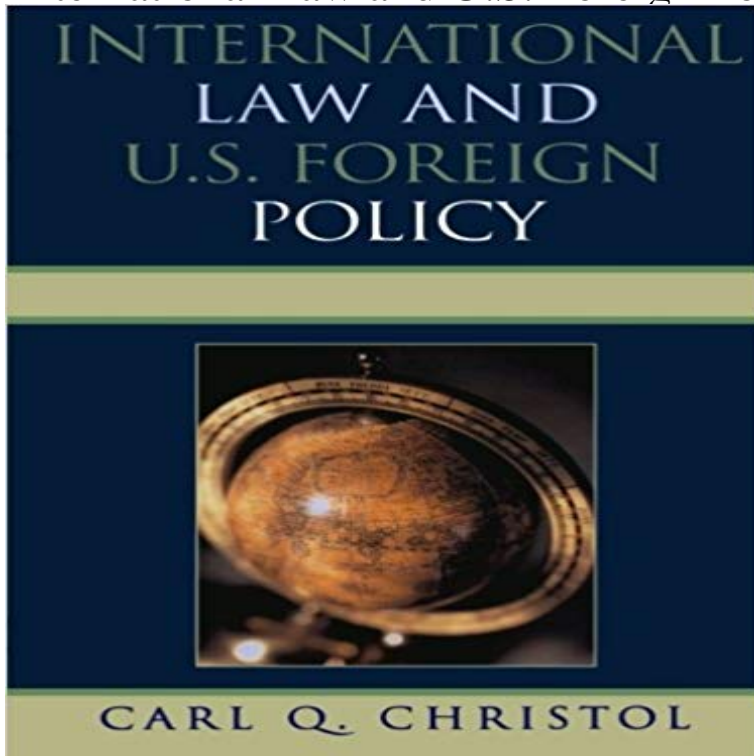


International Law and U.S. Foreign Policy
