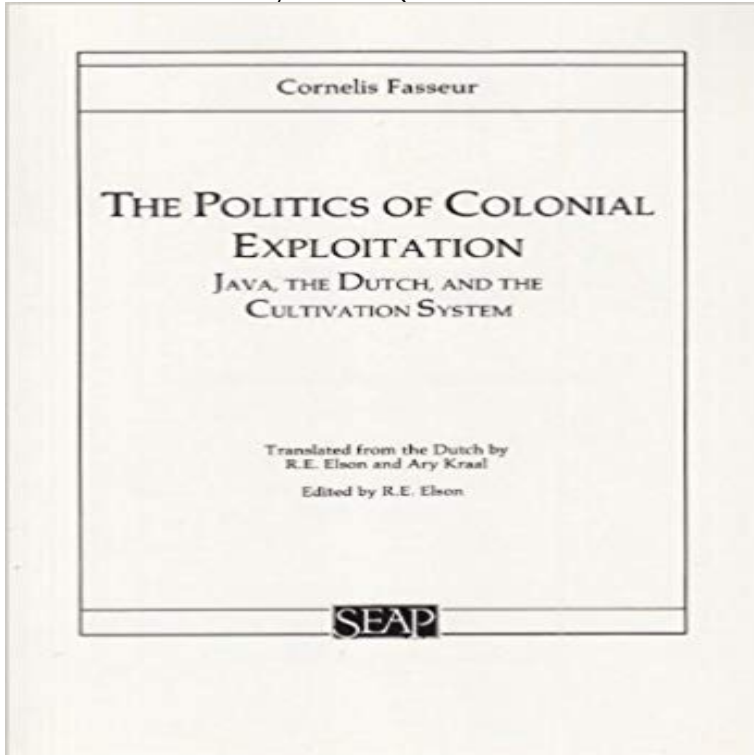


The Politics of Colonial Exploitation: Java, The Dutch, and the Cultivation System (Studies on Southeast Asia)
