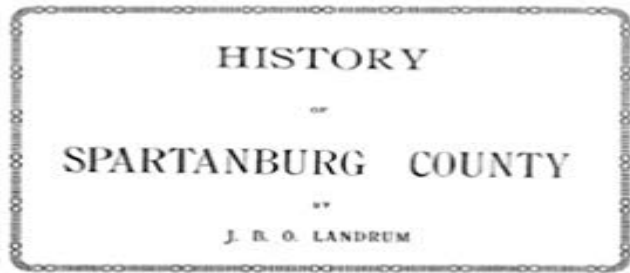


History of Spartanburg County [South Carolina]
