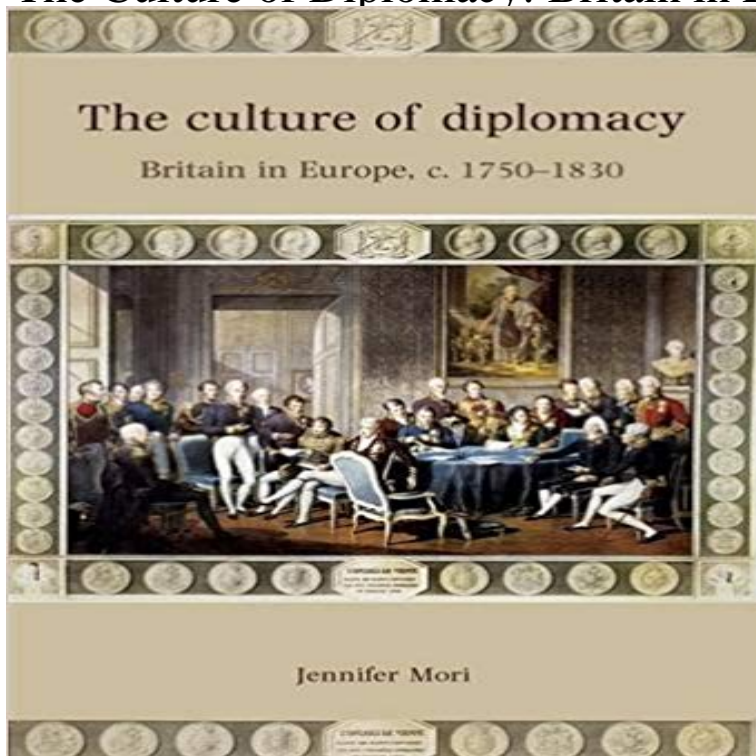


The Culture of Diplomacy: Britain in Europe, c. 1750-1830
