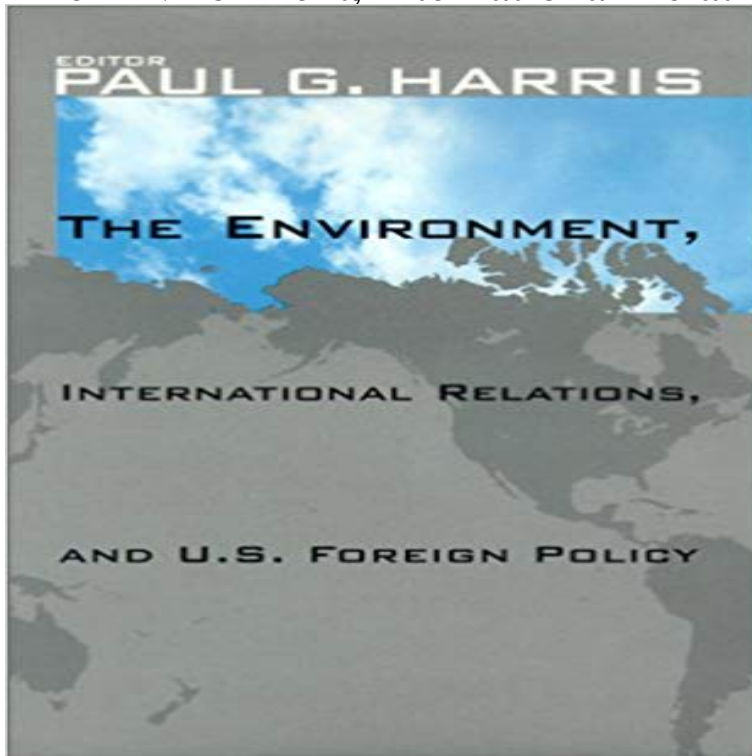


The Environment, International Relations, and U.S. Foreign Policy
