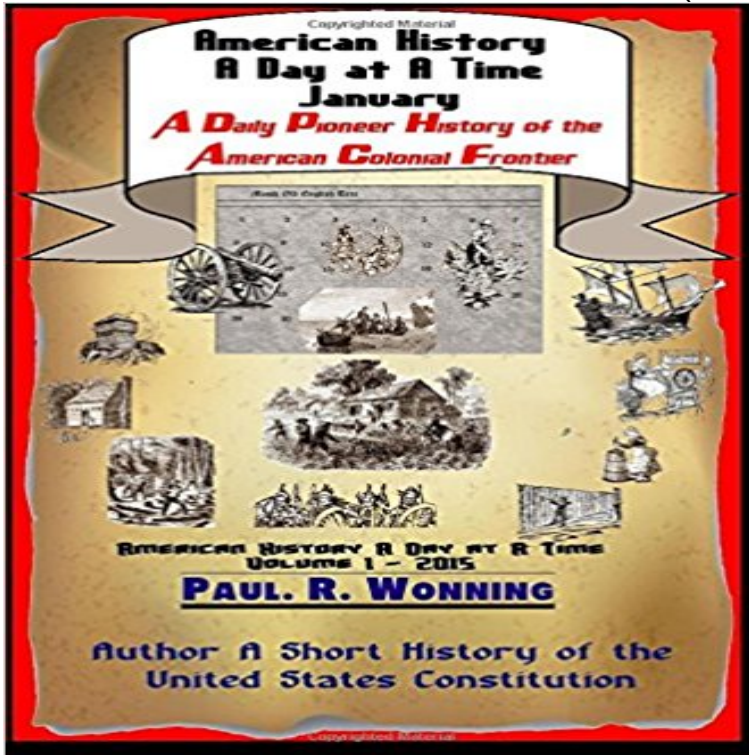


American History A Day at A Time - January: A Daily Pioneer History of the American Colonial Frontier (Volume 1)
